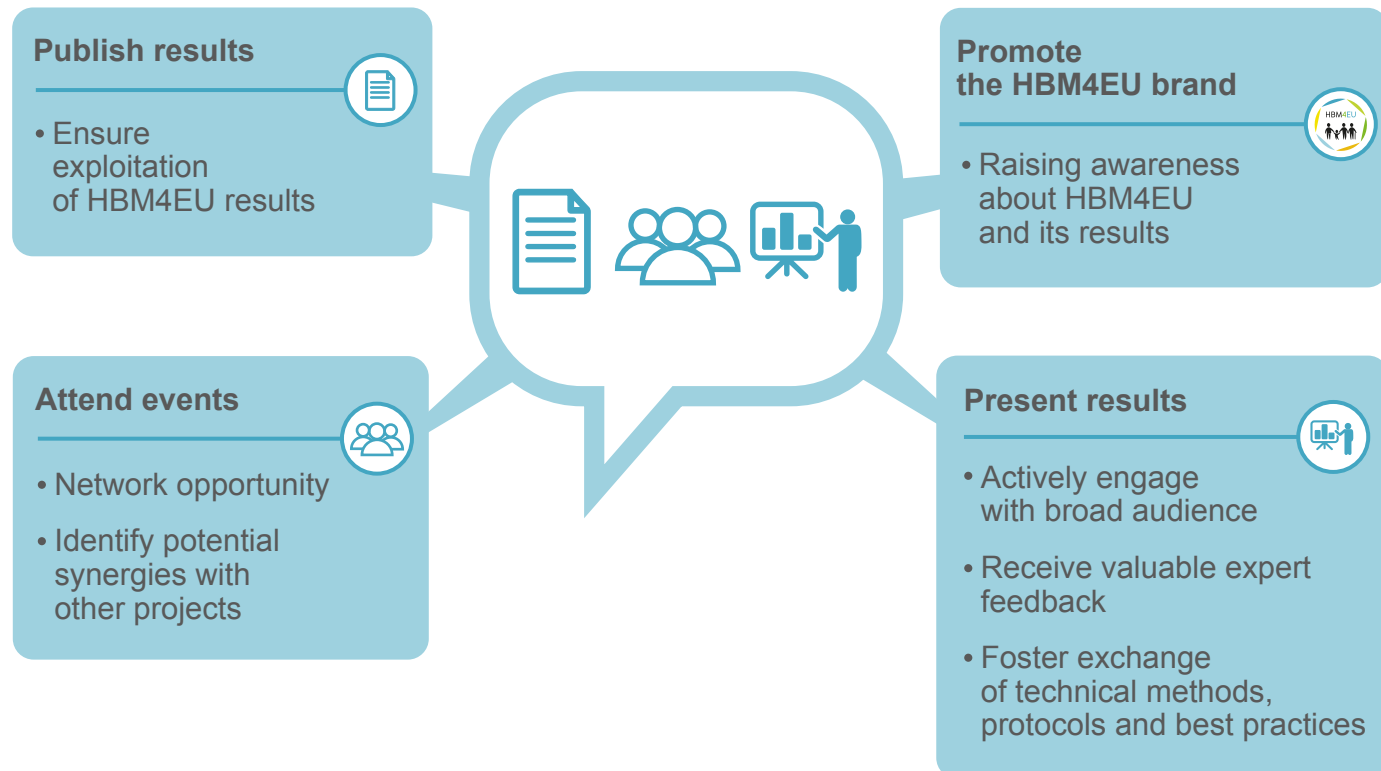

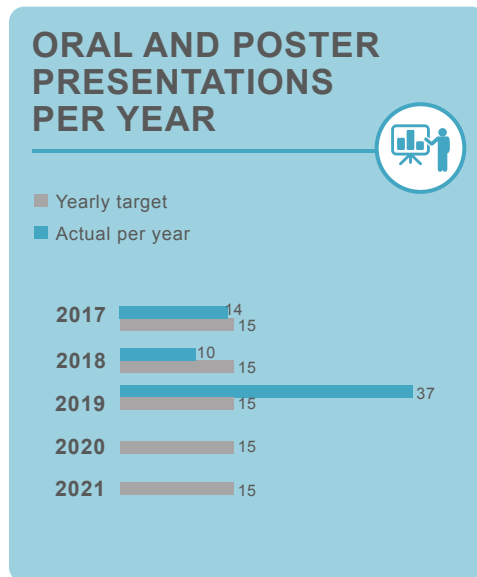
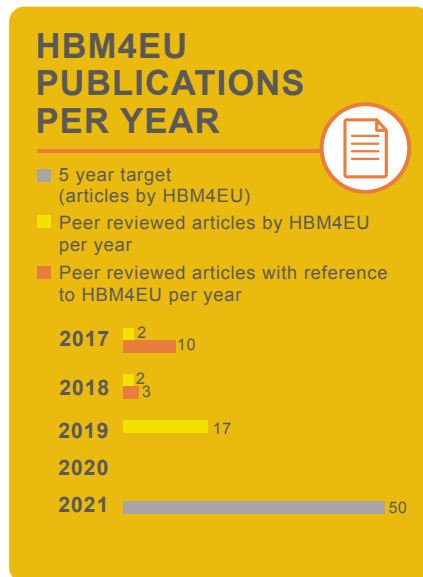
- In 2019 17 peer reviewed articles by HBM4EU have been published.

## RESULTS



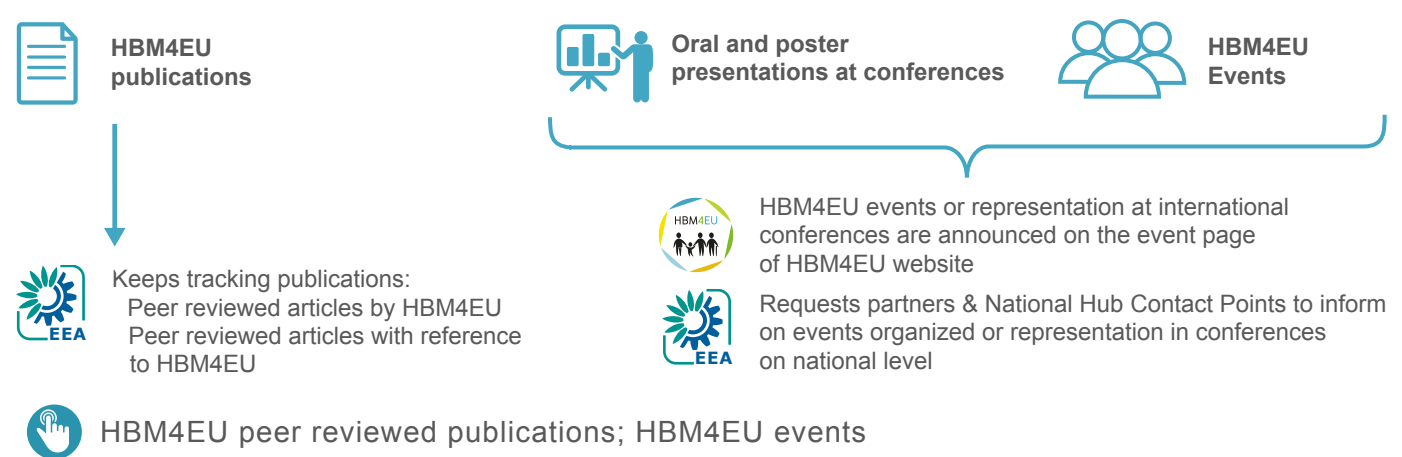
**ON TRACK**
