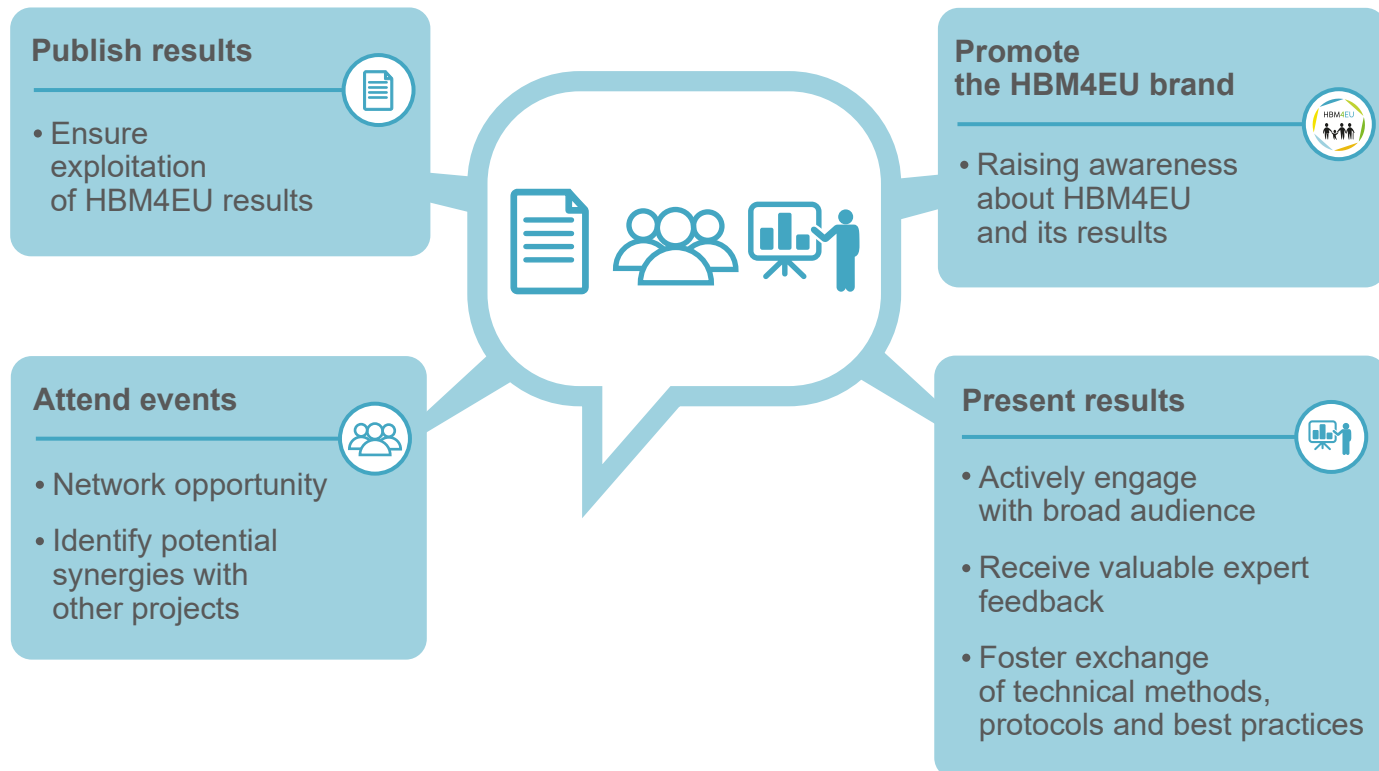

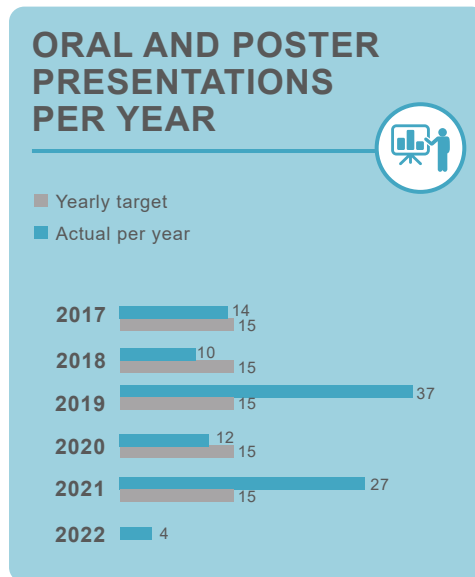
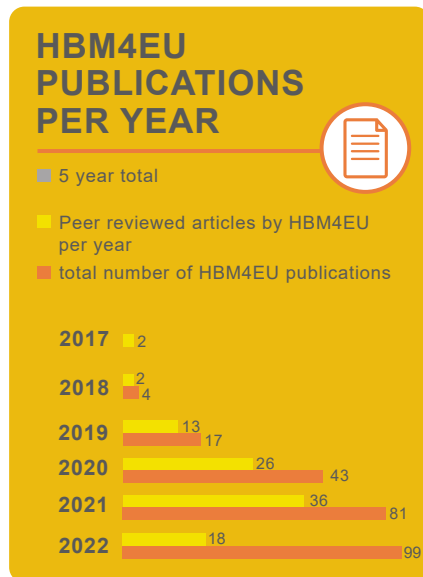
- More than 90 peer review publications by HBM4EU have been produced during the project

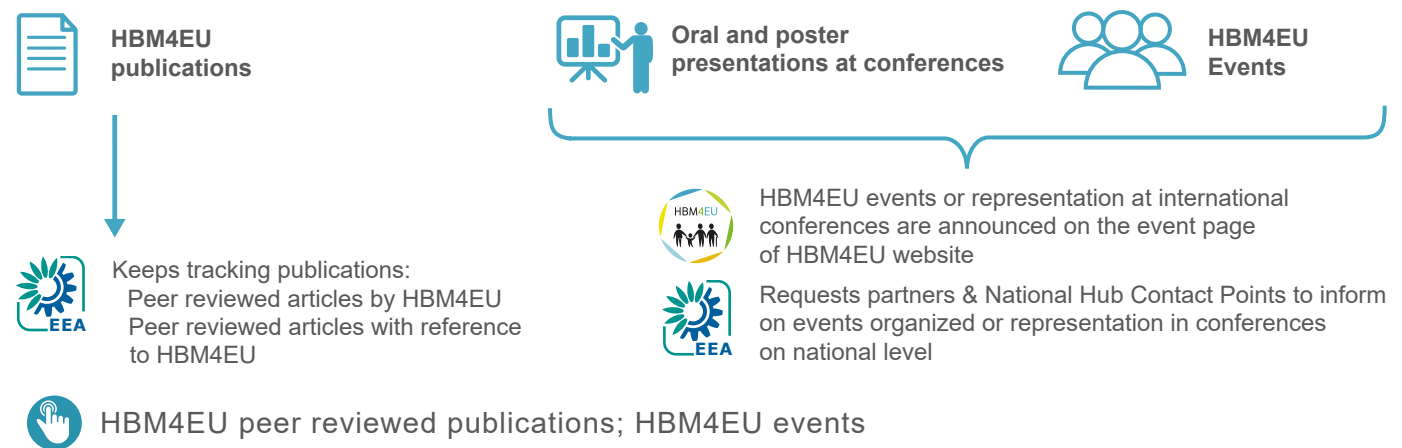
